- 1. The ACT Junior Restricted Cup shall be conducted in one division Boy's and Girl's combined
- 2. Entry is open to all TBA registered players who have not reached the age of 18 years on 1st January 2017. Participants must have completed an All Events entry prior to the check in time advised below in the current ACT Championships, held in conjunction with this tournament.
- 3. ELIGIBILITY- Entry is restricted to bowlers averaging 169 or less for boys, and 159 or less for girls, using the same entering average as the current ACT Championships, held in conjunction with this tournament.
- 4. ALL TBA RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL APPLY TO THIS TOURNAMENT. Any occurrence not covered by these rules will be determined by the Tournament Committee.

 - a. The minimum number of finalists in each division is 4. Fewer finalists in either division shall result in the event being cancelled, if the ACT Junior Restricted Cup is cancelled all qualifying attempts refunded.

- 8. The cost of qualifying shall be \$20.00, highest singles series bowled in the championships will be used to qualify.
