Tenpin Bowling Australia (TBA) Limited are seeking Expressions of Interest (EOI) from junior athletes who are current TBA Junior Silver Members in 2017, interested in attending the 2017 National Junior Development Camp being held at the AIS in Canberra from Friday the 7th of July through to Monday the 10th of July 2017.

TBA is committed to supporting the development of our junior athletes and providing pathways and opportunities to support our elite and developing athletes to reach their potential. Therefore the camp is open to both elite juniors as well as emerging athletes that have been talent identified who possess the potential to be future champions in our sport.

Selection Criteria

A Selection Committee will be formed to select the successful athletes. Their decision will be final. The 8 athletes (4 boys and 4 girls) selected to represent Australia at the 2017 Asian Schools Championship will have automatic admission to the camp. The remaining athletes will be selected with the aim to identify Australia's up and coming young athletes. The following MAY also be considered in the final selection process;

- Current and past performances (up to 18 months prior to the date of selection) in any State, National and / or International tournament;
- Previous results in international teams (if applicable);
- Potential shown to compete at an international standard
- Exceptional physical or mental capabilities while competing in any State, National and / or International tournament;
- Cohesive temperament and skillset in a team environment;
- A demonstrated ability to take direction from coaching and managerial staff;
- Consistency in standards of behaviour, attitude and sportsmanship; and
- A capacity to be an ambassador and mentor with dignity, humility and professionalism

Selection Committee

- The Selection Panel, will comprise of: Shane Bernhardt (Chair), Jamie Taafe, Bianca Flanagan and Michael Craig;
- Members of the Selection Committee must act in the strictest confidence during the selection process;
- Each athlete will be selected by a majority vote;
- There will be no appeals process due to the Talent ID selection process. However, feedback can be provided on request.

Important Information

Athletes who are selected for this development opportunity will learn from some of Australia's top coaches including National Coach Andrew Frawley. . The Junior Development Camp will be held at the AIS in Canberra which will give our new generation of ambitious athlete's access to experienced specialised presenters, cutting-edge, superior quality training and competition facilities as part of our long-term plan to make Australia once again world class.
